WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS

Wright Library provides free wireless (Wi-Fi) access to the Internet for our patrons.

To access the wireless network come to the library. Access is available on the main level of the library. The strength of the signal may fluctuate, depending where you are in the library. Outlets are available in most areas if you need a power source.

To connect the wireless network all you need is a laptop or other device equipped with a wireless network interface card capable of accessing IEEE 802.11b or 802.11g standard signals and the ability to configure your equipment to use the library's connection. If your device is configured to obtain an IP address automatically you should be able to connect immediately. No logins or passwords are required.

The Library staff cannot provide technical assistance. No guarantee can be given that you will be able to connect to the wireless network or that once obtained the connection will not be lost.

The wireless connection is not secure. Patrons are advised not to send sensitive personal data, including credit card numbers and passwords, over the network as these can be intercepted. Maintaining antivirus and security software on your device is the responsibility of the user.

The library is not responsible for any damage, theft, alterations, interference or loss of any kind to a user's equipment, software, data files or other personal property brought into or used at the library.

Library Behavior and Internet Use Policies apply to the use of your own equipment (i.e. laptop) in the library and on its property. Unlawful activities and accessing sexually explicit images and/or obscene materials are prohibited. As always, parents should monitor their children's use of library resources, including the Internet.

Printing is not available from the wireless network. The library has public computers available if you need to print.
