




RAMONA QUIMBY, AGE 8

The further adventures of the Quimby family as Ramona enters the third grade.




BECAUSE OF WINN-DIXIE




HATCHET




CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Four orphans take shelter in an old boxcar during a storm, and, determined to make it their own, they turn it into a safe, cozy home.




MRS. PIGGLE-WIGGLE




A WRINKLE IN TIME

After a stranger arrives in the middle of the night, three students begin a search for a scientist.




LITTLE HOUSE ON THE PRAIRIE

A family travels from the big woods of Wisconsin to a new home on the prairie, where they build a house, meet neighboring Indians, build a well, and fight a prairie fire.




MR. POPPER'S PENGUINS
